# Areas of knowledge to be contemplated:

Linguistic and Literary Studies in English, Critical Literacy in English, Academic Literacy in English, Digital Literacy in English, Language Education in English, Interdisciplinary Social Studies and languages in English.

# Requirements:

- I any Doctoral Degree obtained for at least 2 (two) years;
- II Physical and mental health for the job;
- III Other documents required (UFABC will intermediate visa process for foreigners)

# Remuneration and term of employment:

R\$ 9,916.18 monthly per 40 weekly hours of work for one year, annually extensible up to 4 (four) years for foreigners

# Detailed characteristics of the vacancy:

Special Teaching, Research or Outreach program:

The On-Campus English Language Course (Clip) is a free, in-person course that targets all members of the academic community, including contractors' employees, foundations, post-graduate students, interns, and others. The course has been approved by Netel's Technical Scientific Council.



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The On-Campus English Language Course (Clip), a tuition-free course targeting socioeconomically vulnerable students, was the first course in English as an Additional Language (AL) offered at UFABC. Besides preparing students to deal with their social participation in real-life situations in the English language, the Clip program aims to facilitate language education in a critical and conscious way, developing a set of skills, capacities, social uses and functions of the language, which is seen not only as an instrument of communication, but also as a symbolic system, a technology, and a human means of performance. The goal of the courses is to promote the inclusion of individuals with vulnerabilities, as identified in the university's public policies, in environments where the necessary skills English literacy can be developed, so that participants' performances are not limited by the surrounding social inequalities. Furthermore, Clip aims to develop Language Education in the digital age in an optimized and sustainable way, using technological resources that promote the an appropriate educational environment.
